What is decompression sickness?

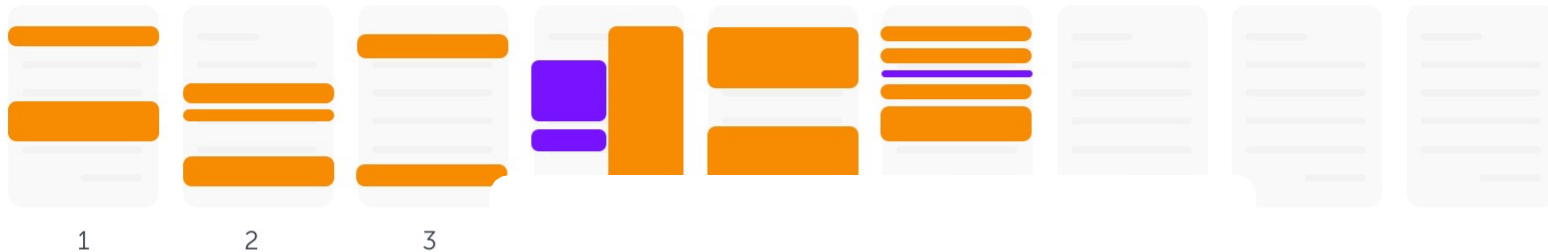
